

### 1st Day of School Supplies

Below are supplies needed for the first day.

#### **Infants**

- You will need to provide bottles. Both the top and the bottle must be labeled with the child's name. Some parents use tape, special label stickers, or Inch Bug orbit labels; it is your preference. If it is breastmilk, you will need to put the date the milk is expressed on the top. Parents typically bring the bottles in a "bottle bag." (If you google bottle bags for baby, they have examples.)
- Also, we ask that you send two-three change of clothes labeled in a ziplock bag.
- If your child takes a pacifier, please send one that can stay at school. Pacifiers cannot be attached to any clips. The pacifier should be labeled with the child's initials.
- If you have an infant that is 7 months or younger, you will need a "sleep sack." We are not allowed to use blankets in cribs; so, teachers will use these instead. Please label your child's "sleep sack."

#### **Toddlers**

- Toddlers will need one-two change of clothes sent in a labeled ziplock bag.
- For nap time, toddlers will need a "nap mat." There are examples below.

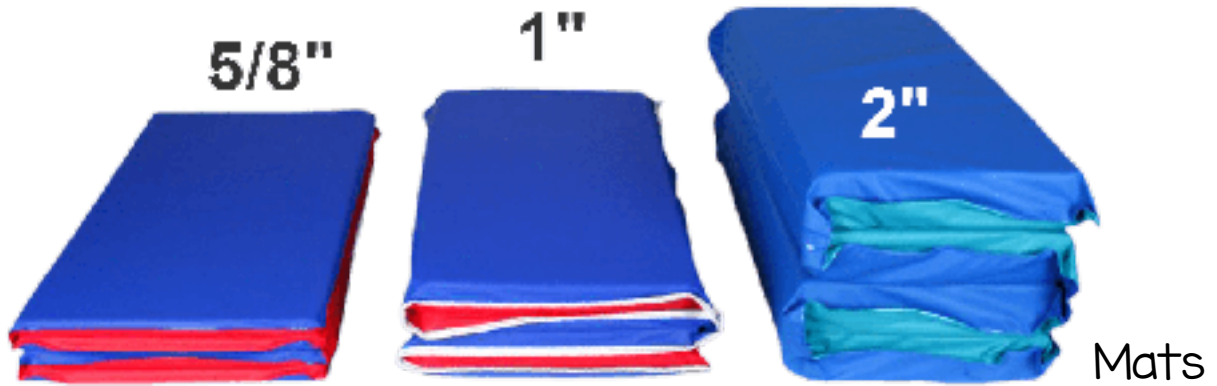
#### **Twos, PreK3, PreK4**

- Students will need a change of clothes sent in a labeled ziplock bag.
- For nap time, students will need 1) a Kinder mat and 2) a "nap mat." There are examples below.

At the start of school, each child will receive an ELC tote bag. The nap mat will be stored in the tote bag, and it will go home every Friday to be washed. You will bring back the items on Monday in the bag.
